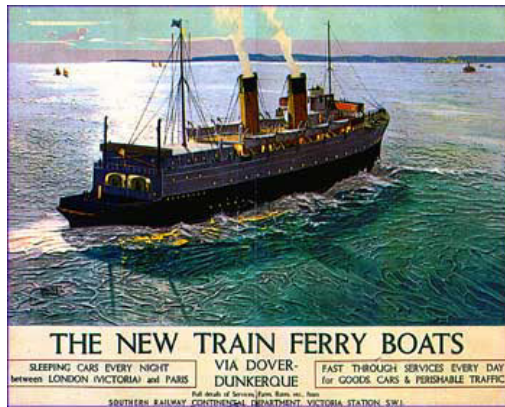


# Southern Railway Day & Night London-Paris Services
